## IMMUNIZATION HOTLINE (212) 349-2664

To attend college in New York State you must prove you are immune to Measles, Mumps and Rubella (German Measles). Students born after December 31, 1956 must provide proof of two doses of measles, one dose of Mumps and one dose of Rubella.

Meningococcal Meningitis, although a vaccine is not mandatory, all students who are enrolled at least half-time (six credits) must sign a Meningitis Information Response Form acknowledging that you have either obtained a shot, will get a shot within 30 days, or have chosen not to get a shot.
